Information and Eligibility Requirements

Scholarship applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Must be a resident of one of the counties which make up the Leon-Bosque RC&D Area. These are Bosque, Brown, Callahan, Comanche, Eastland, Erath, Hamilton, Hood, Mills, Palo Pinto, Stephens, Shackelford and Somervell.
2. Applicants must attend a high school in which all or part of the school district is within one of the counties listed above and be a candidate in good standing for graduation.
3. Must gain admission as a full time student to one of the following institutions of higher learning: Cisco Junior College, Howard Payne University, Tarleton State University, Ranger Junior College, Texas State Technical College or Hill College.
4. Register for 12 semester hours or the equivalent thereof. This requirement may be waived in special circumstances.

For the 2009-2010 academic year, the scholarship fund will award two (2) \$500.00 scholarships to worthy applicants. Future awards will depend on financial condition of the fund.

To receive consideration for the academic year, the attached application must be returned no later than June 1, 2009.

Scholarship funds will be awarded directly to the institution of higher learning when the recipient of the scholarship has registered.
